Semi-Final Official Results Reported for the Assembly District 52 Special General (Runoff) Election

Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean Logan announced Semi-Final Official results for the Sept. 24, 2013 Assembly District 52 Special General (Runoff) Election, with 7.2% of eligible registered voters in Pomona casting ballots. A total of 4,123 ballots were processed and counted on Election Night.

It is important to note that Assembly District 52 is shared with San Bernardino County. Full election results can be viewed here.

The Official Election Canvass period begins on Sept. 25 and ends on Oct. 4. During the Official Canvass, all outstanding provisional and Vote by Mail ballots will be verified and tallied. The RR/CC will also conduct a 1% Manual Audit.

On Oct. 4, the RR/CC is tentatively scheduled to certify the results to the California Secretary of State. On Oct. 8, the Board of Supervisors is tentatively scheduled to declare the election results official.
