NOTICE: Marriage Licenses for Same-Sex Couples May Not Be Issued

Today the United States Ninth Circuit Court of Appeals issued a decision regarding Proposition 8. In a 2-1 decision the court ruled that the proposition is unconstitutional.

At this time the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk is prohibited from issuing marriage licenses and/or performing civil marriage ceremonies for same-sex couples. The stay issued by the Court on August 16, 2010 is still in effect. The Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk is committed to providing all services in compliance with applicable laws.

The Department will issue additional guidance regarding marriage license and civil marriage services for same-sex couples when more details become available.
