Media Logistics for Valentine's Day Ceremonies at the L.A. County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk Labeled Parking Map for Media Available

The Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) has reserved parking spaces and live feed broadcast areas for media on Valentine's Day (refer to attached map).

- Civil ceremonies begin at 8:30 a.m.
- Curbside parking spaces are available for live feed broadcasts.
- Signs will direct media to open parking spaces in Row N.
- Please do not block any handicap or pedestrian access.

To make an appointment for a civil ceremony, couples can fill out an online marriage license application (<u>click here</u>) and bring the confirmation page into one of seven RR/CC offices, along with \$90 for a public license fee or \$85 for a confidential license. At an RR/CC office, couples can then make an appointment for a civil ceremony. A \$25 ceremony payment fee is required to confirm an appointment.
