Semi-Final Official Results Reported for the March 4, 2014 La Cañada Unified School District Special Parcel Tax Election

Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean Logan announced Semi-Final Official results for the March 4, 2014 La Cañada Unified School District Special Parcel Tax Election, with 38.59% of eligible registered voters casting ballots. A total of 5,019 ballots were processed and counted on Election Night.

The Official Election Canvass period is scheduled to begin no later than March 6 and end on March 14. During the Official Canvass, all outstanding Vote by Mail ballots will be verified and tallied. The RR/CC will also conduct a 1% Manual Audit.

An update is tentatively scheduled for Friday, March 7 which will include ballots that were received at the La Cañada-Flintridge City Hall drop off location by 8pm on Election Day.

On Friday, March 14, the RR/CC is tentatively scheduled to certify the election results. On Tuesday, March 18, the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors is tentatively scheduled to declare the election results official.
