Ballot Count Update for the March 4, 2014 La Cañada Unified School District Special Parcel Tax Election

Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean Logan announced a ballot count update for the March 4, 2014 La Cañada Unified School District Special Parcel Tax Election.

The update includes 602 ballots processed since Election Night, consisting entirely of Vote by Mail ballots. To view results, go to http://rrcc.co.la.ca.us/elect.

Please note these results are subject to change throughout the canvass period. All results and updates will be posted online at www.lavote.net as they become available.

During the Official Canvass, all outstanding Vote by Mail ballots are verified and tallied. The RR/CC is also conducting a 1% Manual Audit.

On Friday, March 14, the RR/CC is tentatively scheduled to certify the election results. On Tuesday, March 18, the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors is tentatively scheduled to declare the election results official.
