## Eligible Voters Need to Register to Vote by Feb. 23<sup>rd</sup> for the March 10<sup>th</sup> San Marino Unified School District Special Parcel Tax Election

Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan reminds eligible L.A. County voters that the deadline to register to vote in the upcoming San Marino USD Special Parcel Tax Election is Monday, Feb. 23<sup>rd</sup> at 11:59 p.m.

As of today, there are a total of 9,643 voters and 3,843 Vote by Mail voters within the San Marino Unified School District.

Registering to vote is quick and easy! You can:

- Apply online on your phone, tablet or computer at www.lavote.net.
- Mail a voter registration form, which is available at libraries, post offices and most government buildings. If you are unable to mail your form, drop it off at 12400 Imperial Hwy., Norwalk, CA.
- L.A. County residents who need to verify their voter registration status can go online.
