## RR/CC Begins Mailing More Than 9,600 Vote By Mail Ballots for the March 10<sup>th</sup> San Marino USD Special Parcel Tax Election

The Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan reminds L.A. County voters to request a Vote by Mail ballot by Feb. 23 for the March 10<sup>th</sup> San Marino USD Special Parcel Tax Election. Mailings to all eligible registered voters will continue until Feb. 28.

Requesting a Vote by Mail ballot is easy and can be done <u>online</u> or by using the back of the official sample ballot. San Marino voters who applied for a Vote by Mail ballot can check the status of their ballot online <u>here</u>.

Please note that this is a Vote by Mail election. Voters in the San Marino USD who register to vote by the deadline on Feb. 23 will receive a Sample Ballot Booklet. Beginning January 1, 2015 all Vote by Mail ballots postmarked by Election Day will be counted if received within three days by the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (California Senate Bill 29).

To receive a sample ballot booklet, individuals must be registered to vote. To register to vote or to check voter registration status, residents can visit <a href="www.lavote.net">www.lavote.net</a>.
