L.A. County Polls Open for the March 17, 2015 Senate District 21 Special Primary Election

Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan reminds eligible voters this morning that all <u>165 polling places</u> in Lancaster, Palmdale, and parts of Santa Clarita are now open for the March 17, 2015 Senate District 21 Special Primary Election.

Polls opened at 7 a.m. today and close at 8 p.m. Voters can also drop their Vote by Mail ballot off at any polling place or at the Norwalk RR/CC Headquarters: 12400 Imperial Hwy., Norwalk, CA 90650.
