Tomorrow is Election Day (Media Logistics)

Nearly 5 Million L.A. County Voters Have the Opportunity to Cast Ballots

The Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan encourages nearly 5 million eligible voters to cast their vote tomorrow on Tuesday, June 3, 2014 for the Statewide Direct Primary Election. More than 270,000 voters have already cast their ballot by mail.

Norwalk RR/CC Headquarters has reserved parking spaces and live feed broadcast areas for media (see map) at 12400 Imperial Hwy., Norwalk, CA 90650.

- Curbside parking spaces are available for live feed broadcasts.
- Signs will direct media to open parking spaces in Row N.
- Please do not block any handicap or pedestrian access.

Contests to appear on the ballot include about 40 statewide offices, 19 countywide offices, 18 congressional offices, 9 local offices, 6 local measures and 2 state measures. There are 310 candidates vying over 86 seats.
