## First Election Results Update for the June 7, 2016 Presidential Primary Election

Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced the first ballot counting update for the June 7<sup>th</sup> Presidential Primary Election.

The update includes **66,869** ballots processed since Election Night, consisting of Vote by Mail ballots. The total election results count is now at **1,505,778** which is **31.31%** of eligible Los Angeles County voters.

Please note, these results are subject to change throughout the <u>Official Election Canvass</u> period. The second canvass update will be released on Tuesday, June 14<sup>th</sup>.

During the official canvass, all outstanding ballots will be reviewed, verified and tallied. The RR/CC will also conduct a 1% manual audit. Please view our canvass update schedule on our <u>website</u>.

On July 1<sup>st</sup>, the RR/CC is scheduled to certify the election results. On July 5<sup>th</sup>, the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors is scheduled to declare the election results official.
