Fourth Ballot Counting Update for the June 7th Presidential Primary

LOS ANGELES - Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced the fourth counting update for the June 7th Presidential Primary Election.

The update includes **55,219** ballots processed since election night consisting of **16,582** Vote by Mail ballots and **38,637** precinct ballots. The total election results count is now at **1,841,619** which is **38.3%** of eligible Los Angeles County voters.

On July 1st, the RR/CC is scheduled to certify the election results. On July 5th, the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors is scheduled to declare the election results official.
