L.A. County Polls Open for the June 7, 2016 Presidential Primary Election

LOS ANGELES – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan reminds voters this morning that all <u>4,511 polling places</u> in L.A. County are now open for the June 7th Presidential Primary Election.

Polls opened at 7 a.m. today and close at 8 p.m. Voters can drop their Vote by Mail ballot off at any polling place or at the Norwalk RR/CC Headquarters: 12400 Imperial Hwy., Norwalk, CA 90650.

Voters can find their polling place by:

- Texting the word "VOTE" or "VOTO" to 468683.
- Visiting <u>lavote.net.</u>
- Looking at the back of your sample ballot, or by calling (800) 815-2666, option 1.
