Seventh Ballot Counting Update for the June 7th Presidential Primary

LOS ANGELES - Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced the seventh counting update for the June 7th Presidential Primary Election.

The update includes **49,819** ballots processed since election night consisting of **1,121** Vote by Mail ballots and **48,698** precinct ballots. The total election results count is now at **2,006,976** which is **41.7%** of eligible Los Angeles County voters.

Election results are subject to change throughout the <u>Official Election Canvass</u> period. During the official canvass, all outstanding ballots will be reviewed, verified and tallied. The next canvass update will be released on Friday, July 1st.

On July 1st, the RR/CC is scheduled to certify the election results. On July 5th, the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors is scheduled to declare the election results official.
