The RR/CC Begins Mailing Nearly 1.6 Million Vote By Mail Ballots For the June 7th Presidential Primary Election

LOS ANGELES – The Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan reminds L.A. County voters to request a Vote by Mail ballot by May 31st for the June 7th Presidential Primary Election. Mailings to all eligible registered voters will continue until June 3rd.

Requesting a Vote by Mail ballot is easy and can be done <u>online</u> or by using the back of the official sample ballot. Voters who have applied for a Vote by Mail ballot can check the status of their ballot online <u>here</u>.

To receive a sample ballot booklet, individuals must be registered to vote. To register to vote or to check voter registration status, residents can visit <u>lavote.net</u>. For translated election materials in Chinese, Hindi, Japanese, Khmer, Korean, Spanish, Tagalog, Thai or Vietnamese, call (800) 481-8683.

Beginning January 1, 2015 all Vote by Mail ballots postmarked by Election Day will be counted if received within three days by the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (<u>California Senate Bill 29</u>).
