L.A. County Voters Need to Register to Vote by October 19th For the November 3rd Local and Municipal Consolidated Election

Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan reminds eligible L.A. County voters that the deadline to register to vote in the upcoming election is Monday, October 19th at 11:59 p.m.

As of today, there are a total of 266,529 voters and 85,183 Vote by Mail voters in participating in the Local and Municipal Consolidated Elections.

Registering to vote is quick and easy. You can:

- Apply online on your phone, tablet or computer at <u>www.lavote.net</u>.
- Mail a voter registration form, which is available at libraries, post offices and most government buildings. If you are unable to mail your form, drop it off at 12400 Imperial Hwy., Norwalk, CA.

L.A. County residents who need to verify their voter registration status can go online.
