RR/CC Begins Mailing 505,327 Vote By Mail Ballots for the November 3rd Local and Municipal Consolidated Election

The Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan reminds L.A. County voters to request a Vote by Mail ballot by October 27th for the November 3rd Local and Municipal Consolidated Election. Mailings to all eligible registered voters will continue until October 27th.

Requesting a Vote by Mail ballot is easy and can be done <u>online</u> or by using the back of the official sample ballot. Voters who applied for a Vote by Mail ballot can check the status of their ballot online <u>here</u>.

Beginning January 1, 2015 all Vote by Mail ballots postmarked by Election Day will be counted if received within three days by the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (<u>California Senate Bill 29</u>).

To receive a sample ballot booklet, individuals must be registered to vote. To register to vote or to check voter registration status, residents can visit www.lavote.net. For translated election materials in Chinese, Hindi, Japanese, Khmer, Korean, Spanish, Tagalog, Thai or Vietnamese, call (800) 481-8683.
