## Update: Ballots Left to be Counted for the Nov. 4, 2014 General Election

Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan reported an update on estimates for outstanding ballots to be processed during the canvass period for the Nov. 4, 2014 General Election.

This estimate includes outstanding provisional and Vote by Mail ballots collected at the polls, as well as Vote by Mail ballots received in the mail, damaged ballots and ballots with votes for write-in candidates.
