LOS ANGELES – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan reminds voters they can vote early before Election Day. Los Angeles County voters can visit the Norwalk HQ between 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. and cast their vote.

The two weekends prior to the election (Oct. 29-30 & Nov. 5-6) there will be five (5) additional locations open to the public to visit and vote from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.
