Vote by Mail Request Period Ending for the November 8, 2016 General Election

LOS ANGELES – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan reminds L.A. County voters to request a Vote by Mail by Tuesday, Nov. 1st for the November 8th General Election.

The RR/CC has mailed **2,325,919** Vote by Mail ballots to voters across Los Angeles County.

Voters who wish to request a Vote by Mail ballot can:

- Apply online at lavote.net
- Use the application on the back of their Sample Ballot
- Request a Vote by Mail ballot in person at the RR/CC headquarters: <u>12400 Imperial Highway</u>, 3rd
 Floor (Room 3002), Norwalk CA 90650

Voters who applied for a Vote by Mail ballot can check the status of their ballot online at lavote.net.

There are over 70 Vote by Mail drop-off locations spread throughout the county. Find the nearest drop-off location by visiting <u>lavote.net</u>.

Beginning January 1, 2015 all Vote by mail ballots postmarked by Election Day will be counted if received within three (3) days by the by the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (E.C. § 3020).
