Outstanding Ballots Left to be Processed for the November 8th General Election

LOS ANGELES – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan reported an initial estimate of outstanding ballots to be processed during the official canvass period.

The initial estimate includes provisional and Vote by Mail ballots collected at the polls, as well as Vote by Mail ballots received in the mail post marked on or before Election Day.

This preliminary count of outstanding ballots must be processed and verified before being tallied during the official election canvass period. As canvass staff processes provisional/VBM envelopes these numbers will adjust.

Election results are subject to change throughout the <u>Official Election Canvass</u> period. The first canvass update will be released on Friday, November 11th.
