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RR/CC Begins Mailing More Than 128,000 Vote by Mail Ballots for the Dec. 9, 2014 Senate District 35 Special Primary Election

Any Voter Can Request a Vote by Mail Ballot Until Dec. 2

The Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan reminds voters to request a Vote by Mail ballot by Tuesday, Dec. 2 for the Dec. 9, 2014 Senate District 35 Special Primary Election.

The application period for Vote by Mail ballots began on Monday, Nov. 10, which is also the first day of early voting. In addition, the RR/CC began mailing more than 128,000 Vote by Mail ballots to voters on Monday, Nov. 10.

The RR/CC encourages voters not to miss the opportunity to vote this election. If voters are busy on Election Day, voters can vote by mail.
