Final Election Results Update for the Nov. 4, 2014 General Election

Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced the final ballot counting update for the Nov. 4, 2014 General Election.

The update includes 11,548 ballots processed since the last update on Friday, Nov. 21.

The official election canvass period began on Nov. 5 and ends on Dec. 2. On Nov. 28, the RR/CC is scheduled to certify the results. On Dec. 2, the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors is scheduled to declare the election results official.
