PURPOSE OF THIS ELECTION


The March 7, 2023 City of Inglewood Council District 1 Runoff Election is being held to fill elective offices within City jurisdictions in Los Angeles County.

ELECTION TIMELINE



*The last day a voter can register and be mailed a ballot.

**Vote by Mail, Conditional, and Provisional ballots returned/cast by Election Day will be processed, verified, and tallied.

VOTE CENTER

The Vote Center opens on February 25th.

Voters can return their mail-in ballot at the Vote Center.

Newly eligible voters can register and vote at the Vote Center.



Ballots begin mailing on February 6th.

Sign and date the Return Envelope.

Mark and return your ballot early.



BALLOT DROP BOX

All participating drop boxes open on February 6th.

Mark and return your ballot at any drop box.

Ballot Drop Boxes will close at 8 PM on Election Day.

All ballots must be returned or postmarked by Election Day
