Vote by Mail Ballots in the Mail for Assembly District 49 Special Primary Election

LOS ANGELES – The Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) began mailing Vote by Mail ballots to all registered voters in the 49th Assembly District for the Special Primary Election.

Voters can track the mailing of their Vote by Mail ballot with Where's My Ballot.

We encourage voters to safely participate by returning their mail-in ballot early. There are multiple return options available:

- Return by mail, no postage required
- Return at a Ballot Drop Box
- Drop off at a participating <u>Vote Center</u> beginning February 5

Starting today, the <u>RR/CC Headquarters in Norwalk</u> is available Monday-Friday from 8 AM to 5 PM to vote early in person. Voters will be required to comply with public health and safety guidelines.
