LOS ANGELES – The Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) issued **16,199** Sample Ballot booklets and Vote by Mail (VBM) packets for the February 27th South Pasadena Unified School District Special Parcel Tax Election.

This is an all Vote by Mail (VBM) election, all registered voters eligible to participate will receive a VBM packet.

VBM Drop-Off will be available at the South Pasadena City Clerk's office through January 29 to February 26.

All VBM ballots postmarked on, or before, Election Day will be counted if received within three (3) days by the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (E.C. § 3020).
