Certified Election Results for the March 2 Special Elections

LOS ANGELES – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced the certified election results for the March 2 Special Elections.

A total of **77,324** ballots were processed and counted, with **12.78%** of eligible voters casting ballots in the districts with contests or measures on the ballot. For specific results visit <u>lavote.net</u>.

On Tuesday, March 16 the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors is scheduled to declare the election officially concluded.
