First Post-Election Ballot Count Update for the March 2 Special Elections

LOS ANGELES – The Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) announced the first post-election ballot count update for the March 2 Special Elections.

The update includes **14,417** Vote by Mail and Vote Center ballots processed since Election Night. The total election results count is now **77,072**, which is **12.74%** of eligible Los Angeles County voters residing in the districts with contests or measures on the ballot.

An estimated number of outstanding ballots left to be counted is **730 Vote by Mail ballots** received via USPS, Ballot Drop Box, or at a Vote Center. These estimates are subject to change throughout the Official Election Canvass period as our canvass staff process outstanding ballots.

The next ballot counting update will be on Tuesday, March 9. For specific results visit lavote.net.
