First Post-Election Ballot Count Update for the March 2 Special Elections

LOS ANGELES – The Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) announced the first post-election ballot count update for the March 2 Special Elections.

The update includes **14,417** Vote by Mail and Vote Center ballots processed since Election Night. The total election results count is now **77,072**, which is **12.74%** of eligible Los Angeles County voters residing in the districts with contests or measures on the ballot.

An estimated number of outstanding ballots left to be counted is **730 Vote by Mail ballots** received via USPS, Ballot Drop Box, or at a Vote Center. These estimates are subject to change throughout the [Official Election Canvass](#) period as our canvass staff process outstanding ballots.

The next ballot counting update will be on Tuesday, March 9. For specific results visit lavote.net.
