## Eighth Ballot Counting Update for the March 3 Presidential Primary Election

**LOS ANGELES** – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced the eighth ballot counting update for the March 3 Presidential Primary Election.

The update includes **19,579** ballots processed since Election Night, consisting of Vote Center and Vote by Mail ballots. The total election results count is now **2,121,180**, which is **38.48%** of eligible Los Angeles County voters.

These results are subject to change throughout the <u>Official Election Canvass</u> period as our canvass staff process outstanding ballots.

An estimated number of outstanding ballots left to be counted is **3,600** – consisting of Vote by Mail and Misc. ballots.

We are scheduled to certify election results Friday, March 27. For specific results visit lavote.net.
