## First Ballot Counting Update for the March 3 Presidential Primary Election

**LOS ANGELES** – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced the first ballot counting update for the March 3 Presidential Primary Election.

The update includes **112,114** ballots processed since Election Night, consisting of Vote Center ballots and Vote by Mail ballots. The total election results count is now **1,249,137**, which is **22.66%** of eligible Los Angeles County voters.

These results are subject to change throughout the <u>Official Election Canvass</u> period as our canvass staff process outstanding ballots.

An estimated number of outstanding ballots left to be counted is **573,750**. This estimate does not include Vote by Mail ballots that were dropped at Vote Centers or Drop Box locations on Election Day.

• Conditional Voter Registration: 50,000

• Provisional ballots: 26,500

• Vote by Mail ballots\*: 327,250

• Misc. ballots\*\*: 170,000

We are tentatively scheduled to update election results and estimates on outstanding ballots Thursday, March 5. For specific results visit <u>lavote.net</u>.
