Second Ballot Counting Update for the March 3 Presidential Primary Election

LOS ANGELES – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced the second ballot counting update for the March 3 Presidential Primary Election.

The update includes **45,473** ballots processed since Election Night, consisting of Vote by Mail ballots. The total election results count is now **1,294,610**, which is **23.48**% of eligible Los Angeles County voters.

These results are subject to change throughout the <u>Official Election Canvass</u> period as our canvass staff process outstanding ballots.

An estimated number of outstanding ballots left to be counted is **802,380**. This estimate now includes Vote by Mail ballots that were dropped at Vote Centers or Drop Box locations on Election Day.
