Seventh Ballot Counting Update for the March 3 Presidential Primary Election

LOS ANGELES – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced the seventh ballot counting update for the March 3 Presidential Primary Election.

The update includes **29,672** ballots processed since Election Night, consisting of Vote Center and Vote by Mail ballots. The total election results count is now **2,101,601**, which is **38.12%** of eligible Los Angeles County voters.

These results are subject to change throughout the <u>Official Election Canvass</u> period as our canvass staff process outstanding ballots.

An estimated number of outstanding ballots left to be counted is **20,100**.

- Conditional Voter Registration: 10,500
- Provisional ballots: 5,000
- Vote by Mail ballots*: 3,600
- Misc. ballots**: 1,000
