Sixth Ballot Counting Update for the March 3 Presidential Primary Election

LOS ANGELES – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced the sixth ballot counting update for the March 3 Presidential Primary Election.

The update includes **149,657** ballots processed since Election Night, consisting of Vote Center and Vote by Mail ballots. The total election results count is now **2,071,929**, which is **37.58%** of eligible Los Angeles County voters.

These results are subject to change throughout the <u>Official Election Canvass</u> period as our canvass staff process outstanding ballots.

An estimated number of outstanding ballots left to be counted is **64,000**.

Provisional ballots: 10,000Vote by Mail ballots*: 25,000

• Misc. ballots**: 9,000
