Last Day to Request a Vote by Mail Ballot for the March 5 General Law and Charter City Elections

LOS ANGELES – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan reminds eligible voters in Los Angeles County that **Tuesday, February 26 at 11:59PM** is the deadline to request a Vote by Mail (VBM) ballot.

As of today, the RR/CC has issued **272,570** Vote by Mail ballots. Voters can request a Vote by Mail ballot by:

- Applying online at <u>lavote.net</u>
- Returning the VBM application on the back of the Sample Ballot
- Requesting a Vote by Mail ballot in person at the RR/CC headquarters: <u>12400 Imperial Highway</u>, 3rd Floor (Room 3002), Norwalk CA 90650

The newly redesigned Vote by Mail materials are easier to read, easier to understand, easier to fill out and easier to return – and, no postage is required to return the ballot. Track the status of your ballot online at lavote.net.

There are **12** VBM drop-off locations for voters to drop off their ballot in-person. Find your nearest <u>VBM</u> <u>drop-off location</u>.

Please note all VBM ballots postmarked by Election Day will be counted if received within three (3) days by the by the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (E.C. § 3020).
