# Vote by Mail Ballots Mailed for the March 5 General Law and Charter City Elections

**LOS ANGELES** – The Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) began mailing **254,022** Vote by Mail (VBM) ballots for the March 5 General Law and Charter City Elections.

Request a VBM ballot <u>online</u> or by filling out and returning the back side of the sample ballot booklet. Track the status of your ballot online with the <u>VBM status tool</u>.

The Vote by Mail ballots are easier to read, easier to understand, easier to fill out and <u>no postage is</u> <u>required</u>. Get the <u>facts and review the FAQs</u>.

There are **12** VBM Drop-Off locations open for voters to securely drop off their ballot in-person. Find the nearest location to you.

Starting today, any voter eligible for this election can visit our <u>Norwalk</u> office on the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor and vote early.
