First Election Results Update for the March 5 General Law and Charter City Elections

LOS ANGELES – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced the first ballot counting update for the March 5 General Law and Charter City Elections.

The update includes **13**,**674** ballots processed since Election Night, consisting of Vote by Mail ballots. The total election results count is now **70**,**884**, which is **14**.**30**% of eligible Los Angeles County voters.

The estimated number of outstanding ballots left to be counted is **3,034** consisting of the following:

Provisional ballots: 2,700Vote by Mail ballots*: 134

• Misc. ballots**: 200

This estimate includes additional Vote by Mail Ballots postmarked on or before Election Day and received through today (E+3). These results are subject to change throughout the <u>Official Election</u> <u>Canvass</u> period as our canvass staff process VBM envelopes.
