## Vote by Mail Request Period Ending

Consolidated Municipal and Special Elections Take Place on March 7, 2017

**LOS ANGELES** – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan reminds L.A. County voters to request a Vote by Mail ballot by Tuesday, February 28<sup>th</sup> for the March 7<sup>th</sup> Election.

As of today, the RR/CC has mailed **2,281,007** Vote by Mail ballots to voters across Los Angeles County.

Voters who wish to request a Vote by Mail ballot can:

- Apply online at lavote.net
- Use the application on the back of their Sample Ballot
- Request a Vote by Mail ballot in person at the RR/CC headquarters: <u>12400 Imperial Highway</u>, 3<sup>rd</sup> <u>Floor (Room 3002)</u>, Norwalk CA 90650

Voters who applied for a Vote by Mail ballot can check the status of their ballot online at lavote.net.

There are 69 Vote by Mail drop-off locations spread throughout the county. Find the nearest <u>drop-off</u> <u>location</u>.

Beginning January 1, 2015 all Vote by mail ballots postmarked by Election Day will be counted if received within three (3) days by the by the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (E.C. § 3020).
