Third Election Results Update for the March 7th Election

LOS ANGELES – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced the third ballot counting update for the Consolidated Municipal and Special Elections.

The update includes **46,030** ballots processed since Election Night, consisting of Vote by Mail and provisional ballots. The total election results count is now **891,037**, which is **16.96%** of eligible Los Angeles County voters.

For specific tallies, visit <u>lavote.net</u>. For updates, follow the RR/CC on Twitter <u>@LACountyRRCC</u>. There are approximately **9,000** unprocessed provisional ballots left to be counted.

These results are subject to change throughout the <u>Official Election Canvass</u> period as our canvass staff process provisional/VBM envelopes.

The fourth and final canvass update should be released on Monday, March 20th, which is a revision of the original schedule. It is the intent of the Department to certify the election on Tuesday, March 21st barring any unforeseen changes in the canvass process.

During the official canvass, all outstanding ballots will be reviewed, verified and tallied. Please view the **REVISED** Canvass Update Schedule on our website.
