#### First Post-Election Ballot Count Update for the City of Inglewood Council District 1 Runoff Election

**LOS ANGELES** – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced the first post-election ballot count update for the City of Inglewood Council District 1 Runoff Election.

The update includes **584** ballots processed since Election Night. The total election results count is now **2,881** which is **16.44%** of registered voters. Election results can be viewed on [LAVOTE.GOV](https://LAVOTE.GOV).

The estimated number of outstanding Vote by Mail ballots to be processed is **nine (9)**.

The RR/CC will continue to accept Vote by Mail ballots that are postmarked by Election Day and received through Tuesday, March 14 (E+7). These ballots are not included in the estimate.

The RR/CC prioritizes the timely processing, verifying, and counting of outstanding ballots in the [Official Election Canvass](#).

The next ballot count update is **Friday, March 17** when the RR/CC is scheduled to certify election results.
