Los Angeles County's Election Administration Plan is Now Available for Public Comment

LOS ANGELES – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced the 2022 Election Administration Plan (EAP) is available for public review and comment on <u>LAVOTE.GOV</u>.

The EAP includes the RR/CC's strategy to:

- Administer elections under the California Voter's Choice Act
- Communicate the County's voter education and outreach plan
- Identify and operate Vote Center and Ballot Drop Boxes
- Staff Vote Centers and provide multilingual services
- Deploy security and contingency plans

The RR/CC will hold two (2) virtual public hearings for the public to provide feedback on the EAP.

The first public hearing will take place on Wednesday, March 23 from 5:30 PM to 6:30 PM, and a second public hearing on Thursday, March 24 from 12 PM to 1 PM.
