First Election Results Update for the Special Elections

LOS ANGELES – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced the first ballot counting update for the Special Elections.

The update includes **18,440** ballots processed since Election Night, consisting of Vote by Mail and Provisional ballots. The total election results count is now **83,083**, which is **10.6%** of eligible Los Angeles County voters.

The estimated number of outstanding ballots left to be counted: **1,750** Provisional ballots and **525** Vote by Mail* ballots.

This estimate includes additional Vote by Mail Ballots postmarked on or before Election Day and received through today (E+3). These results are subject to change throughout the <u>Official Election</u> <u>Canvass</u> period as our canvass staff process VBM envelopes.
