Second Election Results Update for the Special Elections

LOS ANGELES – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced the second ballot counting update for the Special Elections.

The update includes **1,966** ballots processed since Election Night, consisting of Vote by Mail and Provisional ballots. The total election results count is now **85,049**, which is **10.8%** of eligible Los Angeles County voters.

The estimated number of outstanding ballots left to be counted is 178 Vote by Mail ballots.

This estimate includes additional Vote by Mail Ballots postmarked on or before Election Day and received through today (E+3). These results are subject to change throughout the Official Election Canvass period as our canvass staff process VBM envelopes.
