Vote Centers Open on Election Day for Assembly District 62 Special Primary Election

LOS ANGELES – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced Vote Centers are open and ready for voting for the Assembly District 62 Special Primary Election.

Vote Centers are open from 7 AM to 8 PM for safe in-person voting or to return a completed Vote by Mail ballot. All locations will follow current public health and safety guidelines.

The safest way to participate in this election is to return the Vote by Mail ballot by mail (no postage required), in a participating Ballot Drop Box, or at a Vote Center.
