## Vote by Mail Ballots Mailed for Assembly District 62 Special Primary Election

**LOS ANGELES** – The Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) began mailing Vote by Mail ballots to all registered voters in the 62<sup>nd</sup> Assembly District for the April 5<sup>th</sup> Special Primary Election.

Voters can track the mailing of their Vote by Mail ballot with Where's My Ballot.

We encourage voters to safely participate by returning their mail-in ballot early. There are multiple return options available:

- Return by mail, no postage required must be postmarked by Election Day
- Drop off at a <u>Ballot Drop Box</u>
- Drop off at a <u>Vote Center</u> (beginning March 26)

Starting today, the <u>RR/CC Headquarters in Norwalk</u> is available during normal business hours to vote early in person. The Ballot Drop Box is also available 24-hours to return a completed ballot. Voters who visit the RR/CC HQ are not required to make an appointment; however, they will be required to follow public and health safety guidelines.
