Vote Centers Open for April 5 Assembly District 62 Special Primary Election

LOS ANGELES – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced Vote Centers are now open and ready for voting in the Assembly District 62 Special Primary Election.

Vote Centers are open daily from 10 AM to 7 PM for safe in-person voting, or to return a completed Vote by Mail ballot. All Vote Centers will follow current public health and safety guidelines.
