First Post-Election Ballot Count Update for Assembly District 62 Special Primary Election

LOS ANGELES – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced the first post-election ballot count update for Assembly District 62 Special Primary Election.

The update includes **6,968** ballots processed since Election Night. The total election results count is now **29,091**, which is **10.22%** of registered voters. Election results can be viewed on <u>LAVOTE.GOV</u>.

The estimated number of outstanding ballots to be processed is 185 Vote by Mail ballots.

The RR/CC will continue to accept Vote by Mail ballots that are postmarked by Election Day and received through Tuesday, April 12 (E+7). These ballots are not included in the estimate.

All outstanding ballots are verified before being tallied. These numbers will adjust throughout the <u>Official Election Canvass</u> as we receive, process, and tally ballots.

The RR/CC is scheduled to certify election results on Thursday, April 14.
