13,286 Vote by Mail Ballots Mailed for the April 18th Arcadia USD Board of Education Election

LOS ANGELES – The Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) mailed **13,286** Vote by Mail (VBM) Ballots for the April 18th Arcadia Unified School District Board of Education election.

Requesting a Vote by Mail ballot can be done <u>online</u>, or by using the back of the Official Sample Ballot. Permanent VBM voters do not need to reapply for a VBM ballot again.

Check on the status of your VBM ballot by visiting lavote.net.

The deadline to request a VBM ballot is **April 11**. Vote by Mail voters who choose to vote at their polling place on Election Day must bring their VBM ballot to surrender, or they will be asked to cast a Provisional Ballot.

Additionally, today is the first day voters can vote early by visiting our office in Norwalk on the 3rd floor. Our office is open from 8am-5pm.

Beginning January 1, 2015 all Vote by mail ballots postmarked by Election Day will be counted if received within three (3) days by the by the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (E.C. § 3020).
