Vote by Mail Request Period Ending for the April 18th Arcadia USD Board of Education Election

**LOS ANGELES** – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan reminds voters in Arcadia that the last day to request a Vote by Mail ballot is **Tuesday, April 11**<sup>th</sup>.

As of today, the RR/CC has mailed **14,264** Vote by Mail ballots. To learn more about this election view our **Arcadia USD Board of Education Fact Sheet**.

Voters who wish to request a Vote by Mail ballot can:

- Apply online at lavote.net
- Use the application on the back of their Sample Ballot
- Request a Vote by Mail ballot in person at the RR/CC headquarters: <u>12400 Imperial Highway</u>, 3<sup>rd</sup>
  Floor (Room 3002), Norwalk CA 90650

Voters who applied for a Vote by Mail ballot can check the status of their ballot online at lavote.net.

Arcadia City Clerk's office will be serving as a VBM Drop-Off Location for this election.

Beginning January 1, 2015 all Vote by mail ballots postmarked by Election Day will be counted if received within three (3) days by the by the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (E.C. § 3020).
