First Election Results Update for the Arcadia USD Board of Education Election

LOS ANGELES – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced the first ballot counting update for the Arcadia Unified School District Board of Education Election.

The update includes **240** ballots processed since Election Night, consisting of Vote by Mail and provisional ballots. The total election results count is now **3,267**, which is **10.90%** of eligible Arcadia voters.

Voters who have returned their Vote by Mail ballot but did not sign the envelope will receive an "Unsigned Ballot Statement" from our department and have until Wednesday, April 26th to return their signed ballot to our office to be counted.

On Friday, April 28th the RR/CC is tentatively scheduled to certify election results. The following Tuesday, May 2nd the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors is tentatively scheduled to declare the election results official.
