## First Post-Election Ballot Count Update for the City of Compton Primary Nominating Election

**LOS ANGELES** – The Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) announced the first post-election ballot count update for the City of Compton Primary Nominating Election.

The update includes **2,072** Vote by Mail and Vote Center ballots processed since Election Night. The total election results count is now **7,682**, which is **15.64%** of registered voters in the City of Compton.

An estimated number of outstanding ballots left to be counted is **170** Vote by Mail ballots received via USPS, Ballot Drop Box, or at a Vote Center. These estimates are subject to change throughout the Official Election Canvass period as our canvass staff process outstanding ballots.

The next ballot counting update will be on Tuesday, April 27.
